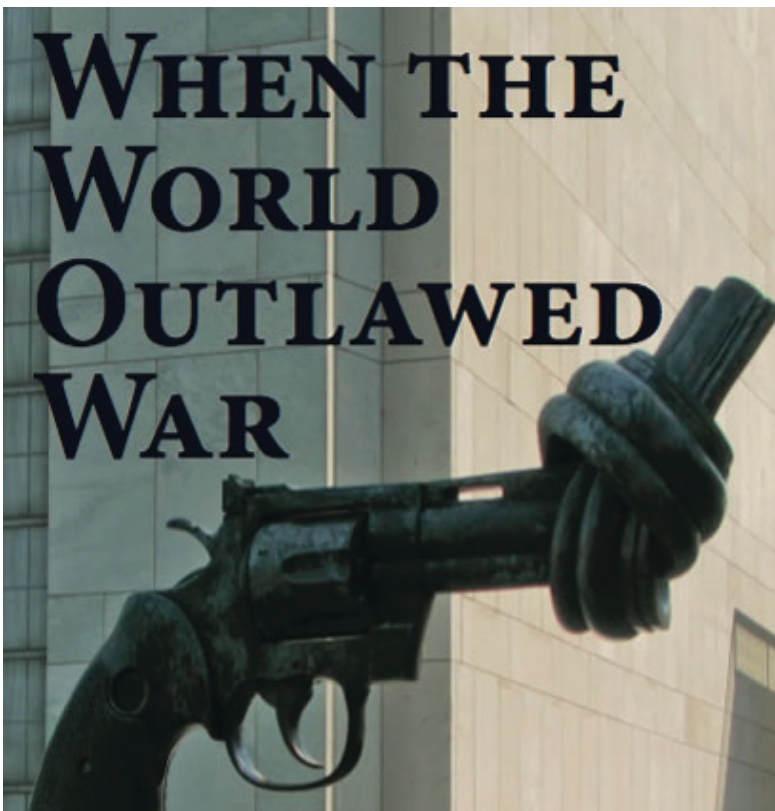


# David Swanson to Speak in Twin Cities on 90th Anniversary of the Kellogg-Briand Pact

August 27, 2018, marks 90 years since the single biggest news story of 1928, the signing by the world's major nations of the Kellogg-Briand Pact, outlawing war.

The treaty, still on the books, is named, as is Kellogg Boulevard in St. Paul, for Frank Kellogg, the only Minnesotan to be awarded a Nobel Peace Prize.

Swanson is the author of *When the World Outlawed War*, as well as *War Is A Lie*, *War Is Never Just*, and numerous other books, including his latest, *Curing Exceptionalism*.
